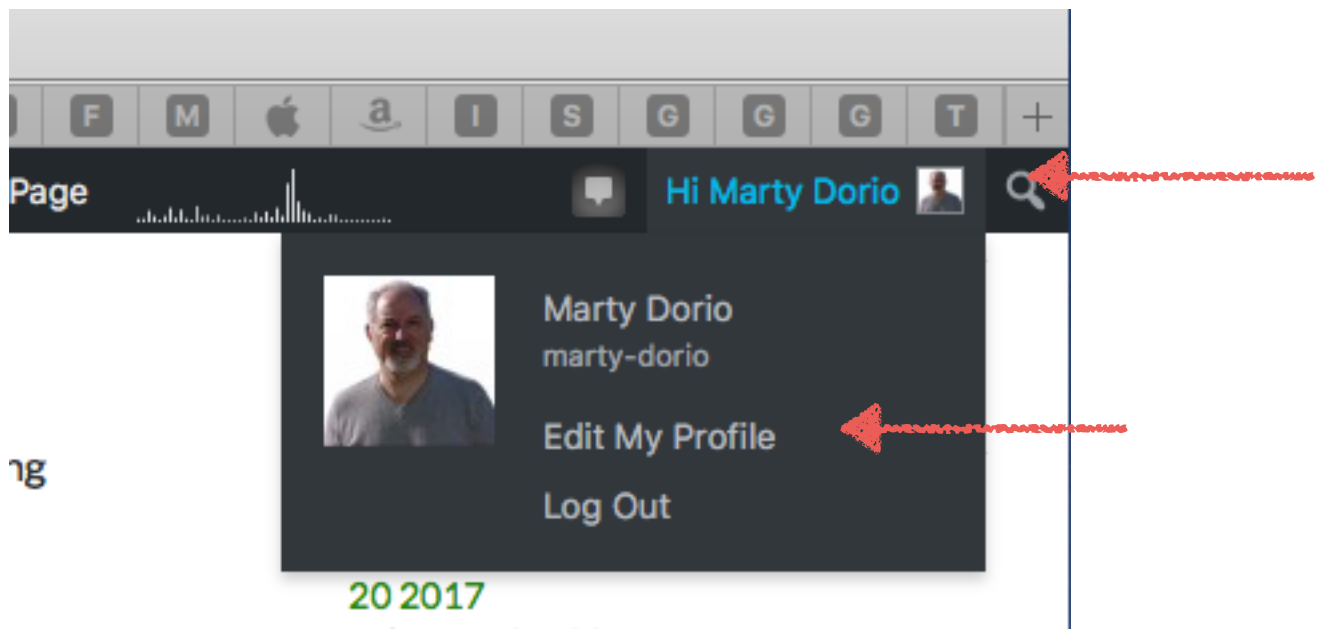
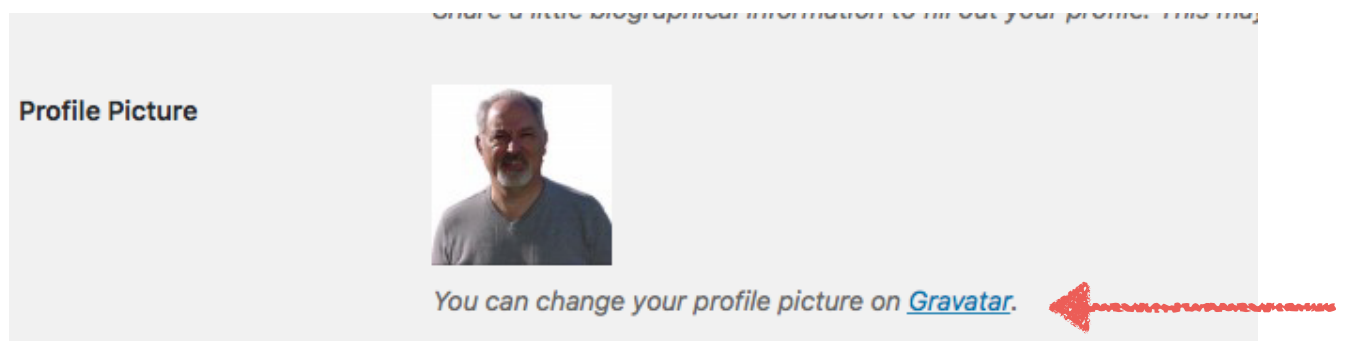


HOW TO SET UP YOUR GRAVATAR PICTURE

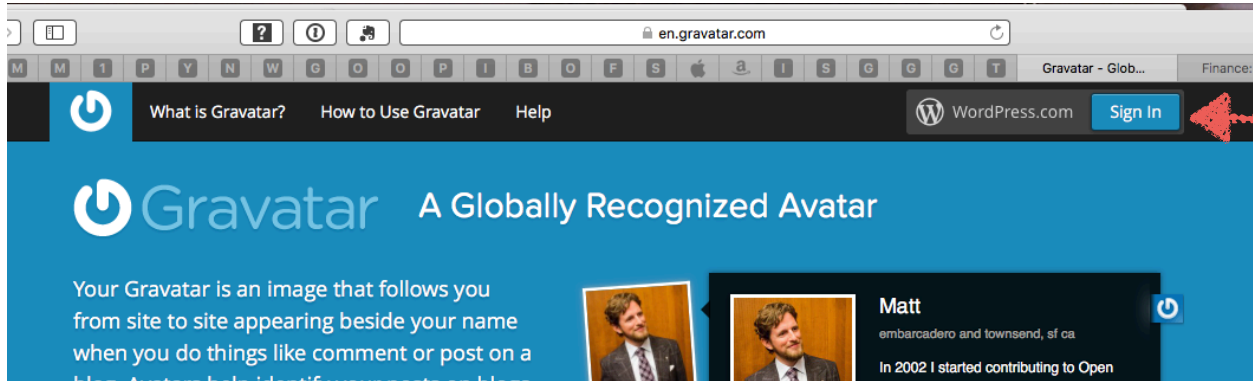
1. Sign in to NaplesMUG.com
2. Click your NAME in the upper right tool bar
3. Click EDIT MY PROFILE




4. Scroll down to your PROFILE PICTURE
5. Click the GRAVATAR link



6. The Gravatar site will ask you to sign in.





7. If you have a WordPress account (not usual) use it. If not (our normal Member will not), create a user name and password.


10. Go back to the gravatar.com site.
